

ADORATION on 1st FRIDAY (June 5)—If interested, sign up required

It has been 3 months since we last held our 1st Friday Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in our parish, due to the many “virus-crisis” restrictions placed on our society from government officials. Although public Masses for the multitudes are still not possible for the time being, due to the current restrictions of 10 or less people allowed to gather by law in one place, we are going ahead with plans for restoring our parish’s Adoration tradition on the 1st Friday of June (the 5th), with even more time to allow for your personal prayer time with the Lord that day. We will have Adoration from 7 a.m. till 8 p.m. that day, although only 10 or less are able to be in the church at one time. Wearing a face mask is required, and keeping a distance of at least 6 feet away from others, as mandated currently by the State, is still in effect, in order to better ensure safety for everyone who wishes to participate. If you are interested in coming that day for such devotional prayer, we ask that you please sign up through Fr. Steve by emailing him at Fr.Steven.Lape@dor.org or by calling him on his cell phone: 607-333-0112. Do not call the Parish Office to sign up. Fr. Steve needs to make sure that all the regulations required at this time by the State and the Bishop’s office are being followed. In order to better ensure that everyone has a chance to spend some time that day within the maximum limit of 10 at a time, we also ask that you only sign up for a maximum of one hour initially. On Friday, you can contact Fr. Steve to see if there are open spots on the Adoration schedule to allow yourself to enjoy for more time there.
