ST. IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA

If the Catholic Church were just a human organization, she could never have survived the assaults from outside and the internal betrayals by her own sinful members for the past 2,000 years. But just before He ascended from Earth, the risen Jesus had promised His Apostles: *“I am with you always, to the close of the age”* (Mt 28:20). It was during one of the saddest periods in church history, the corruption of the Renaissance Church and the Protestant revolt, that God raised up one of his greatest champions to defend and rebuild the crumbling and beleaguered Body of Christ, St. Ignatius of Loyola. In 1491, Ignatius was born in northern Spain, the youngest of 13 children. His mother died while he was an infant. Growing up as a page in the courts of a Governor, with his family’s heroic military history, and reading many romantic tales of adventure instilled in him one dream: that of worldly glory as a soldier. Ignatius followed a reckless life of brawls in taverns, womanizing and many other crimes. It was in 1521, while defending the Basque city of Pamplona, that his dreams of military glory were shattered, along with his leg. This injury led to his conversion through a long and painful recovery with only 2 books to read. One: a life of Christ book and The Lives of Saints book, which began with, *“A saint is a knight in service to his Lord.”* The reading resulted in his conversion, which was reinforced by a vision of Our Lady holding the Child Jesus; he began to hate his former sins, especially those of the flesh. 
